

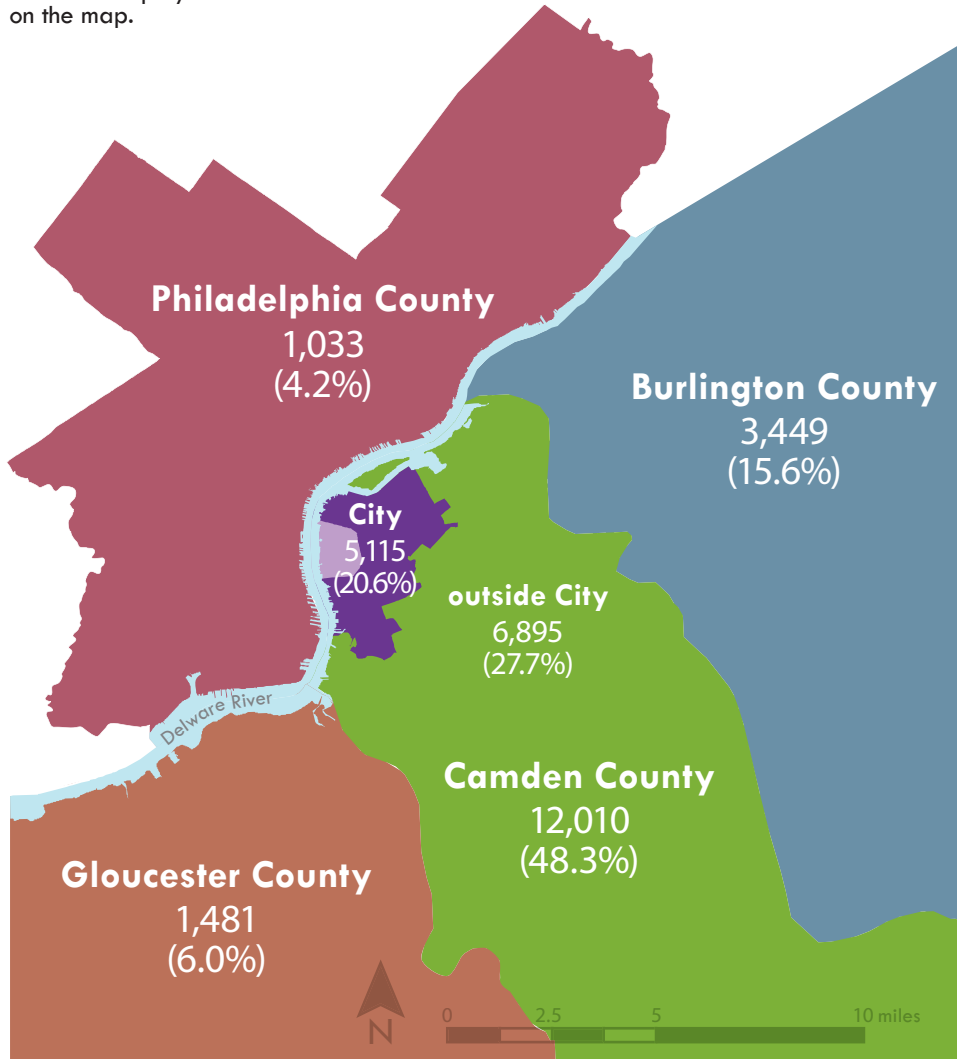
Where do Camden Residents Work?

Only 1/5 of employed residents work in the City, while 1/2 work outside of the County.

Overview: Camden's unemployment rate in 2008 was 11.7%, leaving roughly 24,850 Camden residents employed.¹ 79% of Camden residents held their primary job² *outside* the city. Almost half (48%) of Camden residents work in **Camden County**. Of the residents who did work in the **City of Camden**, close to half work in the **downtown area**.³ Only 4% of residents held their primary job in **Philadelphia**.

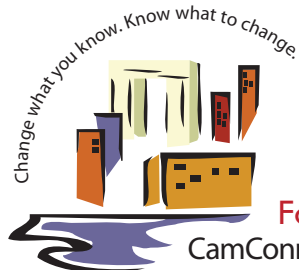
primary job locations for Camden residents, 2008

Definitions:

1. Source data are based on unemployment insurance which excludes self-employed individuals, independent contractors, or those working "under the table" (without paying taxes).
2. A "primary job" is an individual's highest paying employment. All individuals who are employed at any point throughout the year have a primary job.
3. "Downtown Camden" has been defined as the census tracts: Central Business District (6001), Lanning Square (6003), Bergen Square (6004), and Central Waterfront (6005).
